Synopsis:

Part 1: Trauma Informed Interviewing: Trauma informed interviews are designed to improve the quantity and accuracy of testimonial evidence gathered from victims of traumatic incidents. Students will learn about memory and brain processes that effect the encoding and grouping of memory in traumatic circumstances. Students will learn how the fear response of the brain can affect the storage of memory and techniques to illicit recall from victims of trauma while avoiding false memories. Students will learn the 4 stages of conducting a trauma informed interview. **4 POST hours in the area Technical Studies.**

Part 2: Domestic Violence Training: This class will focus on the dynamics of Domestic Violence as well as the various ways that partners are abused in relationships and the cues to look for on domestic violence calls for service. **4 POST hours in the area Technical Studies.**
