This course will explain the definition of domestic terrorism and the actors involved with carrying out such acts, their ideological reasoning and their likely targets. Additionally, this course will explain law enforcement's role to prevent/respond to certain domestic terrorism acts.

Deputy Raoul Williams of the Franklin County Sheriff's Office, and retired Senior US Probation Officer Specialist, will be instructing this course. Deputy Williams is the Sheriff's Office Law Enforcement and Terrorism Liaison to the Missouri Information Analysis Center (MIAC) and his organization's liaison to the St. Louis Fusion Center/Terrorism Early Warning Group, also serving on the Executive Board of the Federal Bureau of Investigation's (FBI) Joint Terrorism Task Force. He is also a member of the FBI's Regional Behavioral Assessment and Consultation Team.
