CRISIS INTERVENTION TRAINING

PREPARE. RESPOND. CONNECT. CARE.



This specialized training equips law enforcement officers, usually from the general patrol division, with the skills to work in partnership with the mental health system, individuals in crisis, and their families.



Attendees are taught to focus on de-escalation and connecting individuals experiencing a mental health crisis with appropriate care. Instead of defaulting to the criminal justice system, officers are trained to redirect people to the mental health system, where they can access a full range of health and social services.



Upon completion, officers are better prepared to facilitate appropriate care for individuals in crisis, enabling communities to feel safer and more confident in calling for help.



This course is open to all members of the law enforcement community as well as government workers that come into contact with the mentally ill.
