



# Traffic Stops and Vehicle Searches

This class will discuss when law enforcement officers can legally initiate a traffic stop, how long that stop can last, and what activities the officer may lawfully engage in during the stop. It will also discuss when officers may search a vehicle and how extensive that search can be under the circumstances. The class will also discuss looking beyond the stop for evidence of other criminal activity.

This class will be worth 6 hours of Missouri CLE. It has also been approved for 6 hours of POST credit, 2 hours of Legal Studies and 4 hours of Technical Studies.
